Postdoctoral Teaching Fellow

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

We are seeking applicants to join the Postdoctoral Teaching Fellow program at the Program on the Environment. Applicants should be committed to interdisciplinary teaching within an environmental context and wish to further their career in teaching and curriculum development. This position will teach or co-teach one course each term (Au/Wi/Sp). Courses will include lower level (100 through 300) core courses and also include opportunities to design and deliver an upper level (400) course. The successful applicant will begin in June 2012.

Postdoctoral teaching fellows are mentored by the Director of PoE. In addition to course preparation, emphasis is put on teaching pedagogy and on working in an interdisciplinary, experiential learning environment. Weekly meetings with the Director and core teaching faculty and staff are used to innovate across core courses and provide a dynamic sounding board for new ideas.

DEPARTMENT INFO:

The Program on the Environment (PoE) is an interdisciplinary environmental studies unit delivering a BA in Environmental Studies. At present, PoE has 294 majors. In addition to general education requirements and foundation courses in quantitative science, biology, earth systems literacy, social science and humanities, students are required to take a series of core courses designed to: inform them about environmental issues and approaches to problem-solving (ENVIR 100); hone student reading, critical thinking, and writing skills within the context of environmental issues (ENVIR 200); help students understand data types and collection methods (ENVIR 250); facilitate critical analysis of multi-stakeholder environmental problems via case studies (ENVIR 300); and guide students through an experiential capstone blending content and skill sets into practice (ENVIR 490, 491, 492).
